I. Rabbi Jonathan Cahn

- A. One of the top spiritual leaders to radically impact our world in modern times.
- B. Author of nine books, including *The Dragon's Prophecy*, a New York Times bestseller.
- C. Recognized as a prophetic voice for our times, for which his teachings and prophetic messages have received over 100,000,000 views:
 - 1. Leader of Beth Israel at The Jerusalem Center in Wayne, New Jersey.
 - 2. Heads up the Hope for the World Ministry, a world outreach of God's Word and compassion for the world's most needy.
 - 3. Played a leading role in two huge prayer and repentance gatherings in the Washington, DC mall during the past six years.

II. End Times Overview

- A. We are End Times believers. Because of that, there are things we need to know to be able to overcome, to prevail, and how to live victoriously.
- B. A taste of things to come will be shared, plus uncensored information that can't be put in a book.

- C. Scriptures will be explored: Some parts have never been translated that hold keys to mysteries of the ages.
- D. A whole another side of the apostasy:
 - I. It will reveal what is happening in our culture.
 - II. The mysteries of the Hebrew letters and numbers and their connection to the End Times.
 - III. The Chiasm, giving a key to End Time prophecy.
 - IV. The mystery of the Hebrew wedding, the bride and groom, and how it links with the End Times.
- E. We are to understand the times and to know what to do because of that. It's not just about *knowing* about the End Times, it's about *living* them.

III. Watchmen and Watchwomen

- A. We are to watch, to know what is coming as much as we can, and we are called to pray—to intercede between heaven and earth.
 - 1. Jonathan had a prophetic foreshadow that **foretold 9/11**, two years before it happened, to the day.
 - 2. A biblical mystery 3000 years ago in the Book of Moses foreshadowed that there would be an attack on the land of Israel in 2023. Enemies of Israel would invade, something that had not happened for decades, and would catch Israel by surprise.

B. Some questions to be answered in this course:

- 1. Is America in Bible prophecy? And if so, where?
- 2. What will the future of America be?
- 3. Was the birth of America linked to an ancient biblical mystery?
- 4. What was the code written over 3000 years ago in the Middle Eastern desert that gives exact times of events now?
- 5. What was the prophetic word appointed from ages past for the exact day on which Israel would be resurrected?

IV. The Last Days and the End of the Age

- A. Moses said in the Last Days that Israel would return to the Lord. (Deuteronomy 4)
- B. Mystery of the Hebrew Holy days, especially the Autumn Holy Days of Israel.
 - 1. The Autumn Holy Days of Israel (Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur) are especially linked to the End Times: The High Holy Days.
 - 2. Between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur are the 10 days called *Yamim Noraim*, or the *Days of Awe / The Awesome Days*.
 - 3. High Holy Days are a picture of the End, so you can say the Last Days are going to be *awesome days*—Days of Awe.
- C. The key sign you're in the Last Days (that they have started): Israel, a nation that had been gone for ages, would come back into the world.
- D. Mystery: The **Parshas**, appointed words in Hebrew scrolls, are appointed to be read in synagogues from ages past for that particular Sabbath.

- We can't put God in a box, but at key times, these words actually match world events, prophetic events.
- 2. One of the *Parshas* spoke of Israel's resurrection, that God was going to bring them back to the land and resurrect them.
- 3. One *Parshas* was appointed from ages past to be read on May 14th, 1948. May 15th was the Sabbath, the day Israel came back into the world. The word said God would raise up that Tabernacle and bring them back.
- 4. Another *Parshas* was appointed, connected to the day of the invasion of Israel, October 7th, 2023.
- 5. The president of Iran had fired all these missiles into Israel. He went up into a helicopter and about 30 days later was struck down. An appointed word for that weekend foretold he would be struck down.
- E. **Mystery:** In the Hebrew Bible, every letter is also a number. (*Warning:* Please don't go crazy with this. Not every word is supposed to mean something profound.)
 - 1. A command that God gave Israel 3000 years ago at Mount Sinai had to do with returning to the land. The command is only one word, but it actually ads up to the year 1948, when Israel returned to the land.
 - 2. We are in a war. The dragon—the enemy—is going full blast against God's people, Israel, and against us. Identifying the strategies he uses can help us overcome him. This can be one way strategies are identified.
 - 3. End Times would have to involve a massive amount of technology.
 - a. We are all on the WWW (world wide web).
 - b. Our **W** equals the Hebrew **vav** (the letter **V**) in Hebrew.
 - c. So our WWW equals vav-vav-vav.
 - d. Vav is the number six: Every computer on the internet is connected to 666. (But don't throw away your computers and other technology just yet!)
 - e. Something can be right in front of your eyes and you just don't realize it.
 - 4. **A mystery in the Hebrew** that's key to decoding the End Times of God: the little Hebrew word "et," found twice in Genesis 1:1. God created the

heavens with the "et," and He created the earth with the "et." It represents Him as the beginning and the end: Both the aleph and the tav, and the alpha and the omega, and is connected to the creation.

- a. The **link** between God and the creation: The Word, the Son, Messiah Yeshua.
- b. The Hebrew letter *tav*, the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet, is in the shape of a cross. It literally means "the cross."
- c. **It's the beginning and the end.** The cross is the end of all things; It's the finishing. It's the end of our sin, the ending of our guilt, the ending of our shame, the ending of our old life.
- 5. The **template of prophecy** is that *the beginning* is the same as *the end*. That's called the *chiasm*.
 - a. Example: "Woe to those who call evil good, and who call good evil."
 - b. Example: "Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed."
 - c. The end of the age will be as the beginning of the age, the chiasm.
 - d. Israel is wiped out of the world and disappears. The *chiasm* says, "but it's got to come back." Israel has to come back into the world. The end of the age shall be as the beginning of the age.
 - e. Western civilization starts out pagan. Then it (and Rome) becomes Christian, and Rome disappears. But at the end of the age, Western civilization will go back to being pagan (a de-Christianization), and we'll have Rome again.
 - f. In the Last Days, therefore, the Book of Acts believer must reappear: On fire, Spirit-filled, powerful, Spirit-radical, revolutionary, world-changing!
- 6. **The mystery of the week.** Hebrew days are not named, except for the seventh day: **The Sabbath**, the holy day, the day of the Lord.
 - a. The Sabbath day begins on Friday night. That's when they put away all of their stuff.

- b. So the Sabbath day comes at the *end* of the week.
- c. As part of the picture, that means the Jewish people will come to the Lord not at the beginning of the age, but at the *end* of the age.
- 7. **Another mystery:** "A day is like 1000 years." The Sabbath of the ages is the millennium—1000 years. That's when the blessing comes, at the end of the ages.

F. The apostasy.

- 1. Usually translated to mean "to fall away from one's faith or from one's stand," and it does mean that.
- 2. It also means "to fall away from one's stasis," or state of being.
 - a. Men will fall away from the state of manhood, women will fall away from the state of womanhood.
 - b. Children will fall away from the state of childhood. Marriage will fall away from the state of matrimony, or marriage.
 - c. Family will be redefined. Humans will fall away from the state of humanness.

G. The mystery of the ages, from the rabbis:

- 1. There would be 6000 years of God's plan, divided up into three ages of 2000 years each.
- 2. The first age of 2000 years is called *the age of Tohu*. The earth was formless and void, before God's revelation, particularly to Israel.
- 3. The second age of 2000 years: God's revelation to Israel, the *age of the Torah*. The ways of God are revealed, from Abraham onward.
- 4. The last age coincides with now, with the coming of the Gospel. Rabbis call this *the age of Messiah*. We're approaching the 6000th year.
- 5. The next 1000 years could be the millennium again, all converging. It depends on when the current age started (destruction of the Temple, 70 AD?) where the prophetic countdowns begin for the next age. We know neither the day nor the hour, but it may tell us what day on the sacred calendar it might happen.

H. **The apocalypse**, for the believer:

- 1. The mystery of the ancient Hebrew wedding is part of the picture for the believer.
- 2. The other side of the apocalypse: The veil will be removed, or the covering.
- 3. Since Laban pulled that trick on Jacob by giving him the wrong wife, Hebrew bridegrooms have become very cautious. They want to know they got the right wife!
- 4. **For us,** removing the veil means we're beholding the glory of God in the face of Messiah.
- 5. For others it means primarily calamity and fear. It's like they're heading for a funeral.
- 6. It's not about that for us. We're about to become one with a bridegroom. This time will be used to bring us closer to Him. **The future is there to accomplish the purposes of God, what God has called you to.**
